Mission

Arts & Crafts furniture became popular in the early 1900's. Gustav Stickley, William Morris and the Roycrofts changed furniture design radically and that influence continues to this day. Designers moved away from the flamboyance of the Victorian era towards function, durability and strong design. Joinery was often exposed, and oak was the dominant wood. Original hardware was hammered and very dark in color.





Mackintosh

Charles Rennie Mackintosh, a Scottish architect/designer/artist, gained recognition in the early part of the 20th century for his unusual use of square patterns combined with sensuous curves. While some consider his work to be in the Arts & Crafts style, others insist he blended Art Nouveau and Modernism. His work included public buildings and private residences and he often developed the furnishings and interior art. These designs compliment Oriental and Contemporary furnishings as well as Art Deco and Arts & Crafts homes. Each is a solid, heavy casting, and true to the period.



Black Iron







Strap Hinges for Doors

HF-15 strap hinges are made from $\frac{3}{16}$ " thick material that is $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Each hinge is drawn out in the traditional way and rolled around a $\frac{1}{4}$ " diameter pin. The butt plate is 3" tall and $2\frac{1}{4}$ " wide (including the barrel) and can be mortised into a door jamb, or surface mounted on the trim or frame surrounding the door.

The usual rule of thumb is that a strap hinge should reach about $\frac{2}{3}$ across the door. We stock 14" hinges (doors up to 22" wide), 20" hinges (doors up to 32" wide) and 24" (doors up to 36" wide). We are happy to make other lengths or configurations.



Stock Pintle Straps

Large doors require wider, thicker and longer straps. We stock 2 lengths of straps for large doors.

The straps shown are $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick and suitable for heavy exterior doors. Determine the length you need by calculating $\frac{2}{3}$ the width of your door.
